event. I learned a lot just watching her."

When Wright married, she lived on a small farm with a B&B in an 1805 home that she slowly refurbished. She would plan excursions for her guests on a regular basis, trying to discover unique and entertaining activities that visitors to the area would remember for a long time. She also worked for a short while as the director of sales and marketing for the Canandaigua Lady. While living in Tennessee, she planned and coordinated seminars and workshops on women's issues.
